

**FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT OF INTER-INSTITUTIONAL
COOPERATION BETWEEN:**

**THE COMMERCIAL COMPANY “BLUEGRACE ENERGY BOLIVIA SRL”
AND THE NATIONAL UNION OF SMALL LIVESTOCK AND FARMERS
“UNAPEGA”**

It is stated in this Interinstitutional Cooperation Framework Agreement, which is signed with the purpose of strengthening both institutions, working jointly and coordinated in search of new business opportunities: planning, implementing, managing, channeling financing and searching for markets for linked projects. to the use of raw materials from Families, Municipal District Unions, Community Associations affiliated with the parent entity of UNAPEGA; among them Productive Development Projects, Fish Farms, Institutional Strengthening, Social Projects, Expansion into New Consumer Markets, which is subscribed according to the following conditions and clauses:

FIRST.- (Of the Parties) .-

- a) On the one hand, the **COMMERCIAL COMPANY “ BLUEGRACE ENERGY BOLIVIA SRL ”** with FUNDEMPRESA Registration Number No. 00463613 and Tax Identification Number 424660027, with temporary legal address at Calle La Plata, 8 Oeste No. 29, Equipetrol neighborhood of the city of Santa Cruz de la Sierra - Bolivia, established by Testimony No. 234/2022, according to certification dated March 7, 2022, granted before Public Notary No. 59, Dr. Betty A. Avendaño Rosales Company Type: Company Limited Liability; legally represented by Messrs.: **JULIO JOSÉ MONTENEGRO** , as **CEO - FOUNDER** , of legal age, qualified by law, of American nationality, with Passport No. 488275078 and **NELSON OSMAR PINEDA MARTÍNEZ** , as **FOUNDER - LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE** of legal age. , qualified by law, of Bolivian nationality, divorced marital status, with Identity Card No. 4756913, Business Administrator Profession, both as Representatives and Legal Attorneys pursuant to Power of Attorney No. 389/2022, dated March 7, 2022, granted before Public Notary No. 59, Dr. Betty A. Avendaño Rosales; who for the purposes of this document will be called **“BLUEGRACE ENERGY”**
- b) On the other hand, the **NATIONAL UNION OF SMALL LIVESTOCKERS AND FARMERS “UNAPEGA”** legally constituted in the Plurinational State of Bolivia, with Supreme Resolution No. 199773 of 07/24/1985, Tax Identification Number – NIT No. 137473024, legally represented by Mr. **DENNIS ATORA IRIARTE** with Identity Card No. 9816728 SC in his capacity as Legal Representative, who for the purposes of this document will be called **UNAPEGA.**

SECOND.- (Background) .-

BLUEGRACE, an association of experts and professionals from around the world with years of experience in the energy sector, with the common goal of making a valuable contribution to the global energy transition towards a net zero future. Witnessing the alarming effects of climate change and the challenges that societies face on their path towards sustainability, we conceived BLUEGRACE ENERGY BOLIVIA SRL as a platform from which we could coordinate our efforts in our mission. Our experts stand out in both clean and renewable energies and have decades of experience leading innovative projects in the field of energy transition towards a model “fit for the challenges of the 21st century”.

At Bluegrace , we adhere to the common principles of professional expertise, highest integrity, and creating real value in both business and society. BLUEGRACE ENERGY BOLIVIA SRL, whose main objective of its legal constitution, is to dedicate itself to environmental management, the protection of the environment and fauna, among other activities.

The **NATIONAL UNION OF SMALL LIVESTOCKERS AND FARMERS "UNAPEGA"** , is a grassroots organization formed from the former beneficiaries of the HEIFER INTERNATIONAL PROJECT (HPI), which began its work activities in Bolivia on May 13, 1957, with the arrival of the first batch of animals donated by the brothers of the Methodist church to the Alto - La Paz international airport, from the USA. The Organization has been legally established in the Plurinational State of Bolivia, under Supreme Resolution No. 199773 of the 07/24/1985, with Tax Identification Number – NIT No. 137473024; Currently, it actively operates promoting the development, production and marketing of small producers in the fields of livestock and agriculture, fundamentally. Our work area is distributed in the different departments of the Plurinational State of Bolivia with a presence at the national level, which It has 11 Municipal District Unions, 90 Community Associations and more than 100,000 families that have directly benefited from the programs and projects carried out by our organization. Likewise, we announce that our organization is affiliated with the Coordinator for the Integration of Peasant, Indigenous and Intercultural Economic Organizations of Bolivia CIOEC-B.

THIRD.- (Object of the Framework Agreement).-

The object and purpose of this inter-institutional framework agreement between the Commercial Company "**BLUEGRACE ENERGY BOLIVIA SRL**" and the **NATIONAL UNION OF SMALL LIVESTOCKERS AND FARMERS "UNAPEGA"** , is to consolidate an inter-institutional relationship lasting over time, with mutual cooperation between parties, to generate development opportunities that will benefit both institutions, including: Families, Municipal District Unions, Community Associations affiliated with the parent entity of **UNAPEGA** and thus achieve the strengthening of social and productive sustenance; with the environmentally friendly use and exploitation of the area's natural resources and their derivatives.

To this end , **BLUEGRACE ENERGY** will accompany and contribute to the development and execution of projects in all territories corresponding to the areas of intervention affiliated with **UNAPEGA** and the Coordinator for the Integration of Peasant, Indigenous and Intercultural Economic Organizations of Bolivia CIOEC-B with a focus of social, environmental and economic impact. These actions will allow us to face the new challenges of society with the improvement and generation of economic resources for "living well" with good health, preservation and sustainable use of natural resources and care of the environment, with the active and joint participation of the parties that constitute fundamental actors of this document.

On the other hand, **UNAPEGA** issues the corresponding permit to enter its territories and grants organic support to **BLUEGRACE ENERGY** so that it can manage all types of Projects in what means sustainable and environmentally friendly use in terms of collection, industrialization and commercialization of the different resources coming from their areas of intervention in a joint and participatory manner.

QUARTER. - (Commitments and Guarantees).-

Through this Interinstitutional Framework agreement:

BLUEGRACE ENERGY , undertakes to:

- (i) Help with Producer Families, Municipal District Unions, Community Associations affiliated with the parent entity of **UNAPEGA** and the Coordinator for the Integration of Peasant, Indigenous and Intercultural Economic Organizations of Bolivia CIOEC-B, so that they can improve their quality of life and their integral development , through the sustainable use of its natural resources (fruits and all local production).
- (ii) Execute projects with the diligence and professionalism required by each specific case.
- (iii) Seek the most optimal and feasible condition for the beneficiary parties.

- (iv) It has the personnel (multidisciplinary team) qualified to face the challenges that each project demands.
- (v) That complies with all legal requirements, has full capacity and legitimacy to formalize this contract.

NATIONAL UNION OF SMALL LIVESTOCK AND FARMERS "UNAPEGA", is committed to:

- (i) Actively collaborate in all the procedures that are necessary for each of the projects to be implemented.
- (ii) Organically support **BLUEGRACE ENERGY** so that it can undertake all types of projects for the benefit of Producer Families, Municipal District Unions, Community Associations affiliated with the parent entity of UNAPEGA and to the Coordinator of Integration of Peasant, Indigenous and Intercultural Economic Organizations of Bolivia CIOEC-B in the areas of intervention.
- (iii) Provide information and all required collaboration in a prompt and timely manner through its affiliated sectors with the field work to be carried out. Formally accrediting the technical staff of the **COMMERCIAL COMPANY "BLUEGRACE ENERGY BOLIVIA SRL"** in all stages of the project(s) to be executed.
- (iv) That complies with all legal requirements, has full capacity and legitimacy to formalize this contract.
- (v) Entrust the **COMMERCIAL COMPANY "BLUEGRACE ENERGY BOLIVIA SRL"** with the execution and start-up of all projects.
- (vi) Guarantee the required volumes and timely delivery of raw materials depending on the projects to be undertaken.

4.1. Purpose.-

Contribute based on a mutual effort and jointly to the comprehensive and agroecological development of producing families, with the perspective of building a society with equal conditions, where families are the fundamental axis of this process.

4.2. Purpose.-

Consolidate and strengthen the process of an agroecological productive development model by strengthening the capacities, abilities and skills of families, communities, productive social organizations, without restrictions or discrimination of any kind, in the sphere of influence of "**UNAPEGA**".

4.3. Specific objectives.-

- Identify genuine needs and develop strategic proposals for human, socioeconomic and agroecological development that are viable and appropriate to family units, with the participation of all the main actors.
- Promote comprehensive sustainable development throughout the area of influence of "**UNAPEGA**" through the execution of main strategies such as: organization, planning, training and communication, at all levels of the organization.
- Strengthen the capacities, abilities and skills of families, or other organizations that bring harmony between social, economic and environmental aspects.
- Manage and channel human, economic, logistical resources, equipment and materials and inputs from national and international institutions, organizations, which allows us to co-execute development programs and projects for the benefit of producer families.

Once the financial resources have been guaranteed, the obligations and responsibilities of each party must be formalized through a specific contract for each project.

FIFTH.- (Form of execution)-

To comply with this **FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT**, the participating Institutions undertake to:

- 1) Hold meetings to coordinate actions, formulate plans and projects.
- 2) Accredite representatives for the signing of the Framework agreement, signing of contracts, in order to facilitate plans and projects.
- 3) Carry out evaluations by jointly monitoring the activities to be developed.
- 4) Comply fully and with the greatest rigor with everything established in the points of this Framework agreement.
- 5) For the execution and start-up of the projects, the **COMMERCIAL COMPANY "BLUEGRACE ENERGY BOLIVIA SRL"**, has total power to select the technical personnel and the executing companies with absolute guidance for each area of operation.
- 6) The **NATIONAL UNION OF SMALL RANCHES AND FARMERS "UNAPEGA"** will accompany the execution as social control through reports on the progress of works and/or fulfillment of objectives, through its representatives.

SIXTH.- (Duration, Renewal and Modification)

This framework agreement will have an initial duration for the entire 2024 administration from its signature, and may be renewed or canceled after joint evaluation and agreement between the parties, through letters or written notifications.

SEVENTH.- (Of conformity)

The parties, on the one hand, the **COMMERCIAL COMPANY "BLUEGRACE ENERGY BOLIVIA SRL"** and on the other the **NATIONAL UNION OF SMALL LIVESTOCKERS AND FARMERS "UNAPEGA"**, express their full agreement with each of the points established in this **FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT OF INTER-INSTITUTIONAL COOPERATION**, and as a sign of acceptance they recognize and subscribe it in triple copy in the city of Santa Cruz de la Sierra - Bolivia on the 15th day of the month of February of the year two thousand twenty-four.
